



RISK ASSESMENT



According to the ISM code, all experienced or observed risks shall be assessed and appropriate actions must be taken. The assessments and actions shall also be documented.

IRIS supports the Risk Assessment process as a formal activity to identify potential hazards and implement appropriate risk mitigation measures prior commencement of work.

In addition to event caused assessments, templates can be defined for routine jobs, work permits or other types of repeated operations where risk assessment is required.
